Player Evaluations - 2009

Player evaluations are required for all players in the 8U, 10U, 12U, & 14U divisions. Please arrive 15 minutes before your designated time for check-in. Those who arrive late will be held over to the next group. Players need to bring their glove, cleats, helmet, bat, and any other equipment they may need. The league will also have bats, helmets & catcher's gear available for use. Please see the times below for your daughter's group, based on player's last name. If your daughter plans to try out for pitcher in the 8U, 10U, 12U, or 14U division, she needs to return at the time designated for pitching evaluations, as indicated below.

Managers/Coaches: All those wishing to volunteer as manager or coach for the 8U division and up should plan on attending the Player Evaluations for their respective divisions. The final selection of managers will be made based on the number of teams needed.

Parents/designated adult catcher, please bring a glove to catch during this part of the evaluation. Upon arrival to evaluations, please make sure you notify the check-in person if your daughter wishes to try out for pitcher.

If your daughter has pitched before and is a designated pitcher for the league but she doesn't wish to pitch any longer, you may request that she no longer be designated as a pitcher. If this option is chosen or if the player does not attend pitching evaluations, the player will NOT be allowed to pitch in ANY league games. This decision is final. Please make sure you understand this rule and your daughter is aware of it. If you are not sure if your daughter is a designated pitcher, please contact the Player Agent.
